He has been actively involved in the development of many of the coastal restoration programs and projects in Louisiana, making significant contributions to the following: the terracing technique, the fore-shore dike technique, the vegetation and Christmas tree programs, the development of operating plans for the Caernarvon and Davis Pond Diversions, the Ecological Review process, the CWPPRA Report to Congress, the recently completed Adaptive Management Review, and the development of the Coast 2050 Plan.

He has served as Administrator for the Coastal Restoration Division since 1989. Currently, he is involved in several on-going restoration activities, including the Coast 2050 Comprehensive Feasibility Study.
